on April 14, 2010 at the Field. The treasurer reported \$1100.00 in checking, and \$2024.30 in savings with \$100 in dues to deposit. The monthly flea market at Hobby Stop was discussed. Members were encouraged to participate.

Eric and Tim reported on the "Funnest Flying Club" event. This will be a fun fly type activity with 4 events: Touch N go, Peanut Butter Cracker - Whistle - Fly timed event, Spot Landing, and Taxi through an obstacle course. Both Seaford and Marks clubs have indicated interest. We will host this first year event on May 16; will have food for sale, raffle tickets for sale, and provide prizes. Rain Date to be June 19. A trophy will be provided to the club with the most points - a prize to be coveted by all, and won back next year by those who lose this first year.

IMAC "Battle at the Bay" was confirmed for the July 31- Aug 1 weekend, no further information is available at this early date.

Safety was discussed- a reminder was made to those present to keep hot low passes out beyond the midpoint of the runway, and to keep combat activities from getting too close to the pits, preferably near the far edge of the runway.

Fertilizer is scheduled for the runway and control line area.
