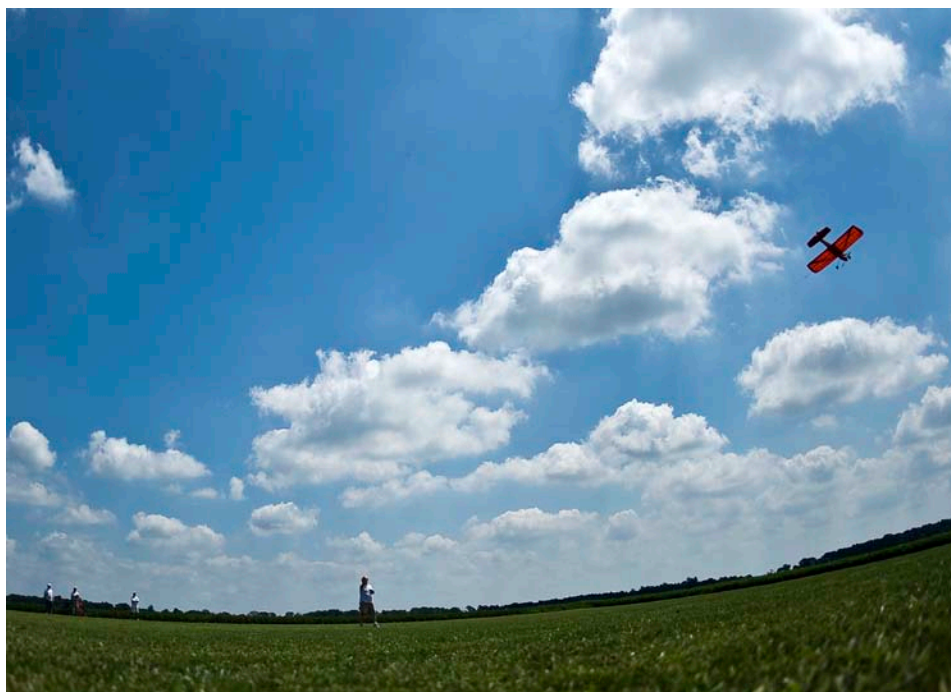

## LAST MEETING

A club meeting was called to order at 7pm at the Field on August 12, 2009. The Treasurer reported balance approaching \$5,000 in checking and \$1,022.92 in savings. This balance is due to the delay in purchasing the new lawn mower engine which is still on order.

The Jim Coll Memorial Control Line Stunt Contest was discussed. A raffle plane complete with engine was announced, a 50/50 drawing and Tim has about 35 pilots expressing interest in attending. Everything is under control-(pun intended)

The members discussed the club picnic on September 26. This event will be a members, guests and visitors fun day with a Scale Theme including Warbirds. The club will have food and drinks available. Members will be encouraged to mark their calendars and let family and friends know the schedule. The Seaford club has invited members to their club fly-in which is to be held on Sept 13. Covered dish optional, but members are encouraged to go fly and have

some fun with our neighbors.

The revised club members section was discussed, and brought up for approval by the membership. A unanimous vote of the members present and the Directors to approve was received. The new rules will replace the old ones on the website. As is often the case, as soon as the vote was taken, there were comments suggesting that other rules be reviewed. It was agreed that the Officers would undertake a complete review of all field rules and bring a recommendation back to the next meeting. It was noted that several typos were found in the rules and that Spread Spectrum was not in place when the rules were drafted, creating a situation where all pilots are required to obtain a frequency pin when flying and impound radios at other times at the field, while there is no purpose for Spread Spectrum frequency pins nor impounding those radios. A copy of the suggested changes will be emailed to members prior to the next meeting if they are available.

The meeting was called to a close at 7:45 pm.

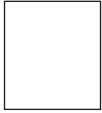
